Stewart Bowling Club	£3,260.00	29/07/2009	A project to replace the old mowers which are used by volunteers from the club members to cut the green during the bowling season. The current mowers are very old and increasingly unreliable and expensive to maintain.
Rudston Village Hall	£1,589.36	29/07/2009	A project to purchase & install curtains & blinds for the village hall windows to improve acoustics, prevent heat loss and enable slide & cinema projection to take place throughout the year.
Burton Fleming Sports & Recreation Club	£2,000.00	29/07/2009	A project to purchase play equipment to be installed by volunteers to create a play area in the village of Burton Fleming.
Creykes Pre-School Playgroup	£4,000.00	29/07/2009	A project to contribute to the running costs of the playgroup which will suffer a considerable drop in income over the coming year due to numbers of children attending.
