York & District Citizens Advice Bureau	£2,000.00	07/09/2010	A project to clear the area behind the CAB office which has become overgrown & derelict. This will involve volunteers from the CAB & create a wildlife garden in an area which is currently an eyesore for visitors & local residents.
York Tree Wardens	£204.00	01/07/2010	The grant would be used to pay for members' travel and other expenses related to our work, including training venue hire and educational costs.
Bishopthorpe In Bloom	£2,000.00	31/03/2010	A project to provide floral displays & hanging baskets throughout the village of Bishopthorpe to encourage the local community to form a group to get involved on a voluntary basis and enter the annual Yorkshire In Bloom competition.
Heslington Scout Group	£2,000.00	31/03/2010	A project to replace the external fire escape stairway at the scout hut following an interior refurbishment. This will improve the appearance of the hut's exterior.
Skelton Village Trust	£1,450.00	31/03/2010	A project to replace fencing and plant new hedging to encourage wildlife. Also to plant a wild flower meadow adjacent to the hedge along with more trees.
Sovereign Park Residents' Association	£2,000.00	31/03/2010	A project to plant trees and erect fencing to more clearly define local rights of way from private property.
